Good afternoon MES families,

We are reaching out to let you know that we have a positive case of COVID-19 for a member of our school community. We have reached out to Chatham Health and their Director for guidance. He has shared which groups need to quarantine based on the information we have at this time. Your family would have been contacted directly if your child was a 'close contact' and needed to be quarantined.

We typically call all families within a classroom so that families can make their own decisions around testing and quarantining - even if their child is not a 'close contact'. When the situation involves bus transportation, we only call the families of students impacted by the seating arrangements - making them a 'close contact'.

We appreciate everyone's efforts in keeping our school community safe in these challenging times.
