

MES Family Update - August 3

Good afternoon Marlborough Families,

We are in the process of creating class lists for students attending in-person school at MES in the fall. After class lists are completed, we will be dividing MES into an A and B school - each containing about 50% of our student body. School A and School B will each contain classes from each grade level (both PreK classes will be in School B). The possibility of going into our Hybrid Model necessitates the creation of an A and B school.

Trying to plan ahead in this very challenging time, we are asking families to email any information that helps us in our process. We cannot guarantee placements, but want to try and work with families to create the most 'doable' structure we can. At this point in time, as outlined in our plan, School A would be in school on Monday and Wednesday and every other Friday. School B would be in school on Tuesday and Thursday and every other Friday. Students would work with their teachers remotely when not in the building.

Please understand that we have many parameters to consider as we are creating the class lists and our A & B schools. We understand the difficulties that many of our families are trying to work through in terms of school and work schedules, but unfortunately there are no placement guarantees. Hopefully with your input, we can accommodate some of the needs that families have in terms of class placement and A/B school determination.
